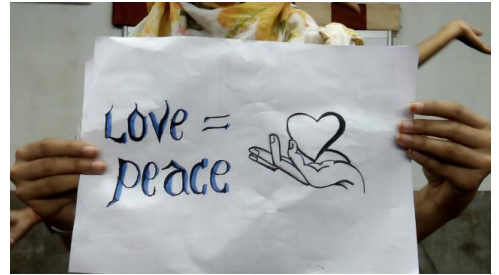


## **20. Celebration of International Day of Peace : (21<sup>st</sup> September, 2016)**
