- On 20th January, 2017 Rotaractors Anjali Singh, Amandeep Singh Jassal and Tasneem-e-Gul attended D.G Visit held at Institute of Engineers, Jamshedpur. Club Secretary Rtr. Anjali Singh presented the annual activity and project report before District Governor Rtn. R. Bharat.
- Rotaract club of Karim City College, Jamshedpur celebrated the Republic Day 2017 with the underprivileged people by giving them *Tiranga* and sweets, under the leadership of Club Secretary Rtr Anjali Singh. Rotaractors made them aware about the importance of Republic Day and Tiranga as well.
