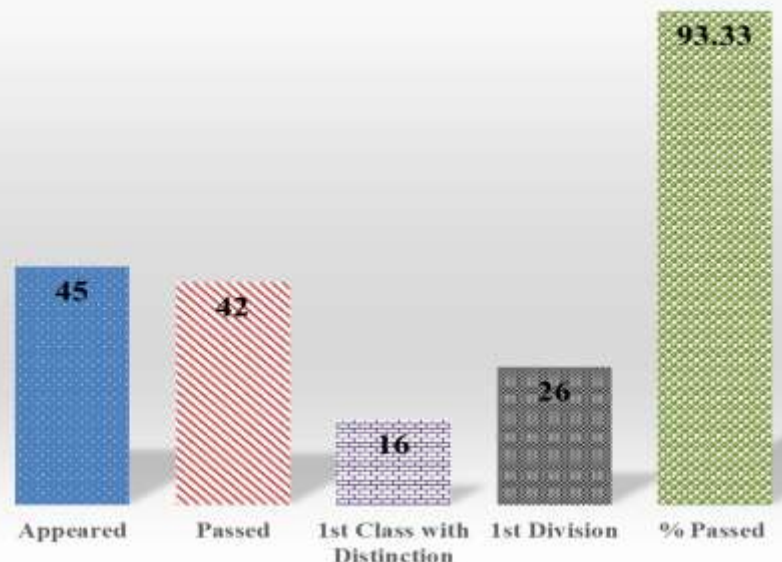

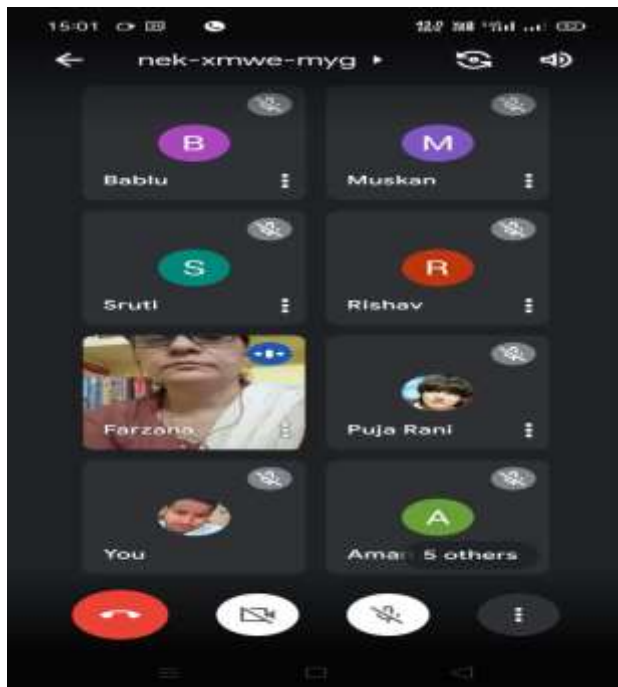

## Topic: Man and Environment

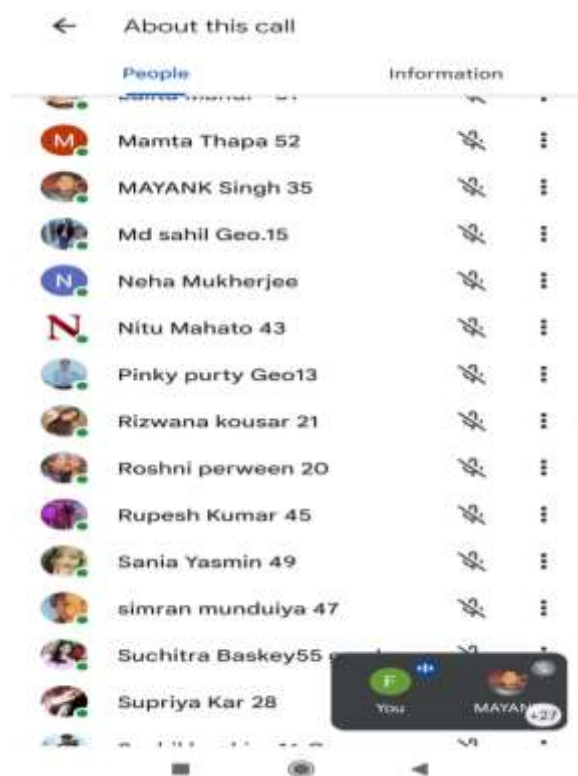
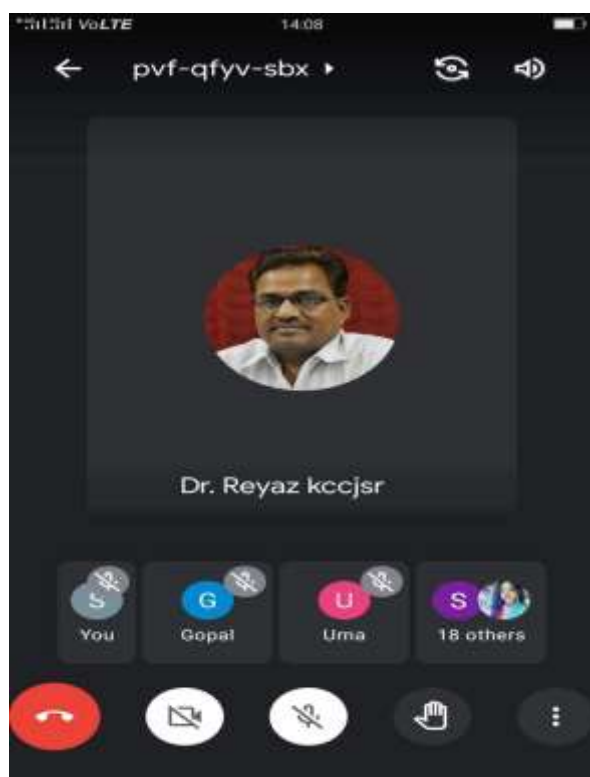

## Topic: Sustainable Development

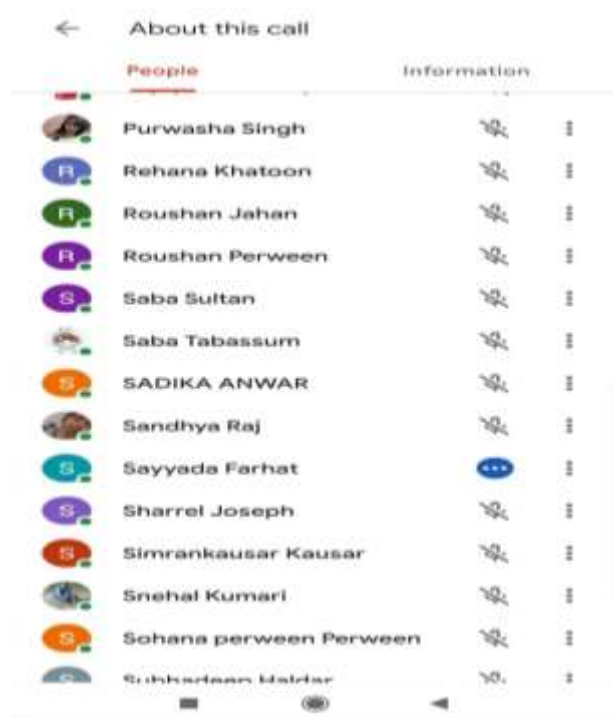
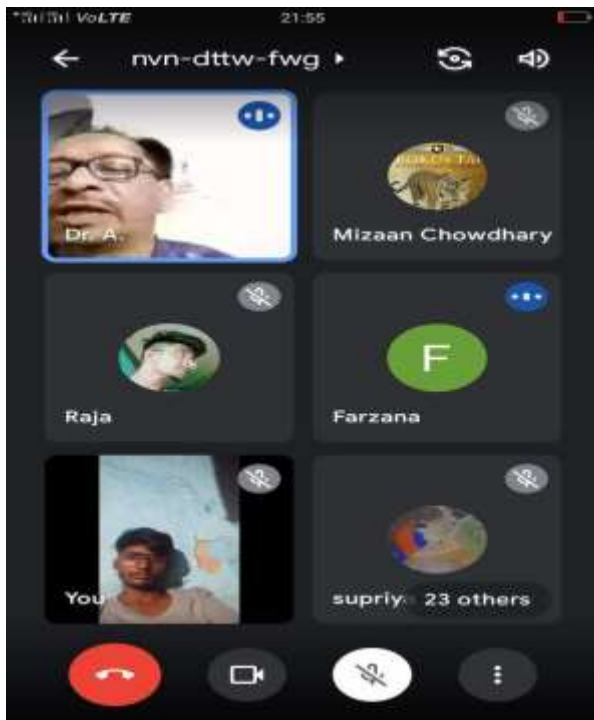


**Topic:** Climate Change and the Effects of El Nino and La Nina
