**ADMISSIONS AND CHALLENGES OF COVID 19**

In the new academic session of 2020-2021, the department of Political Science admitted **87 students in B.A Hons course out of which 65 were boys and 22 girls**. The number of female enrolments has considerably reduced this year which was a matter of concern for us. The female students prefer our campus because it is considered secure and safe for them. We also had **132 students who opted for Political Science as their Generic Elective** paper. This was a period when life was completely abnormal after the COVID 19 pandemic. The college decided to begin the classes in online mode when the college reopened after summer vacation. We started engaging the classes of previous semesters – 5<sup>th</sup>. Soon college asked us to be ready with the final internal marks of **Semester 1 (Session 2019-2022) and Semester 5 (Session 2017-2020)**. We uploaded the final internal marks of Semester 1 (Paper CC1, CC2 and DSC) on 03-07-2020. Again we also uploaded the marks of Semester 5 (Papers- CC11, CC12, DSE1 and DSE 2) on 18-07-2020 on the Kolhan University portal. While we engaged our classes in online mode in July 2020 and August 2020, the conditions were not conducive for offline classes.

**The Registrar of Kolhan University again notified on 10<sup>th</sup> September 2020 and extended work from home from 10<sup>th</sup> September to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020. A meeting of all faculty members was called by our Prof-in-Charge in the college on 11<sup>th</sup> September 2020 to discuss the same and it was decided that online classes will continue as per the order of the Registrar, Kolhan University.**

Classes for the newly admitted students for the academic session 2020-2023 began from 5<sup>th</sup> December 2020 in online mode. The student as well as faculty had many problem with regard to internet, network problems and difficulty in catching up in the virtual mode. Many students did not have an independent smart phone to attend the classes.

## DEPARTMENTAL MEETINGS

The college developed a very good strategy of preserving those written notes on the website of the college under E. EQUIP section which proved to be rich content for all our students and helped them a lot in tacking their examinations.** It was an amazing and new experience for the faculty as well.

The college administration decided to begin the classes of Semester 1 in the first week of December 2020 (5<sup>th</sup> December 2020). in the online mode. The classes could not be started earlier because of Pandemic and lockdown conditions. **Soon after the start of the classes' students were distributed amongst the faculty members for mentoring purposes in a meeting held on 15.11.2021.** In the middle of the session and towards the end meetings were also held to discuss about conducting the internal assessment tests, setting up of question papers and declaring of portion for the Internal Examination. All the faculty members joined hands together to give their best to the students and ensuring quality teaching for our students.
