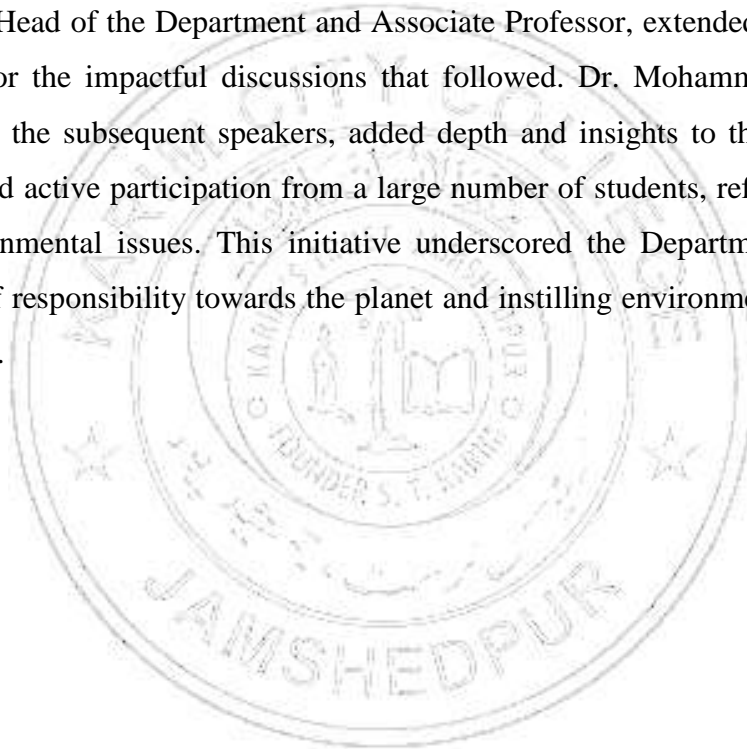


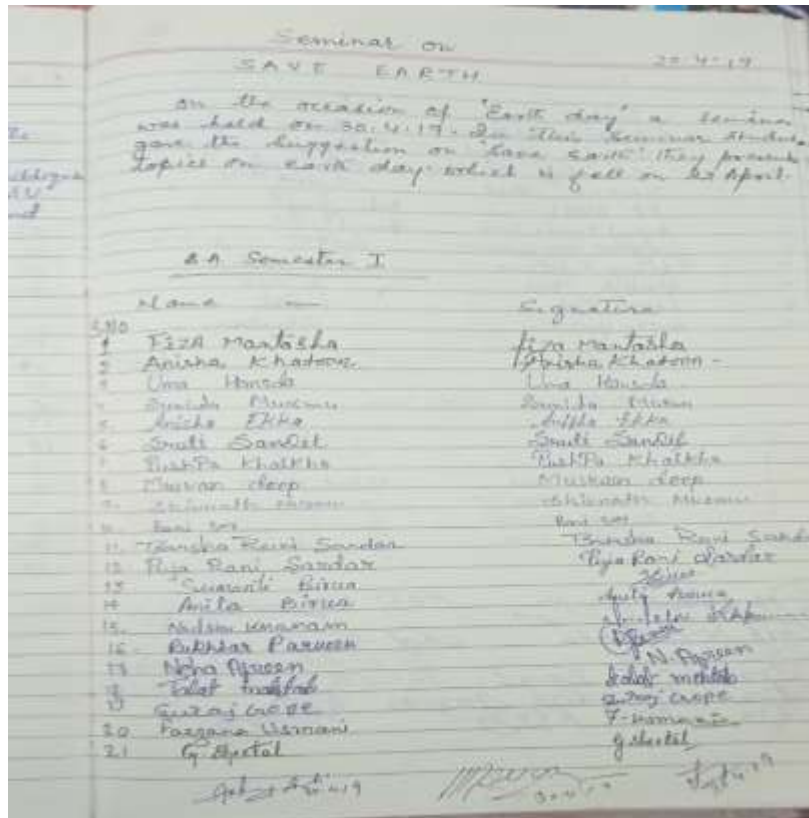
STUDENTS SEMINAR
