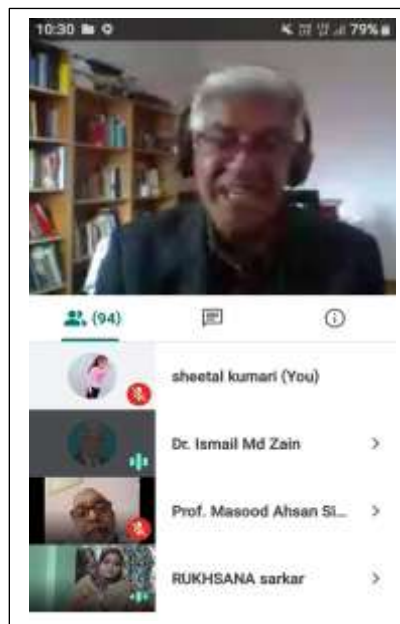
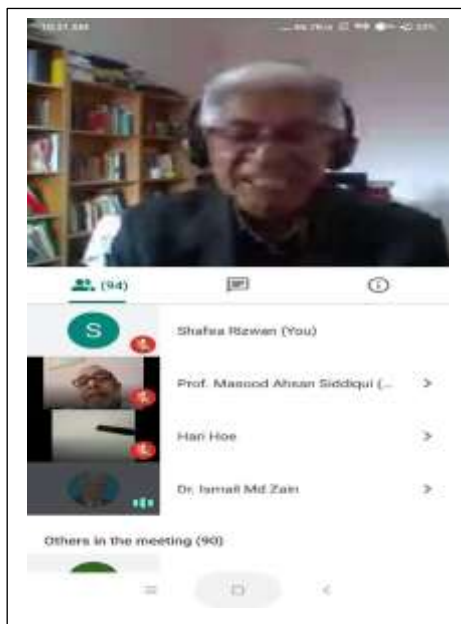
## **INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR**

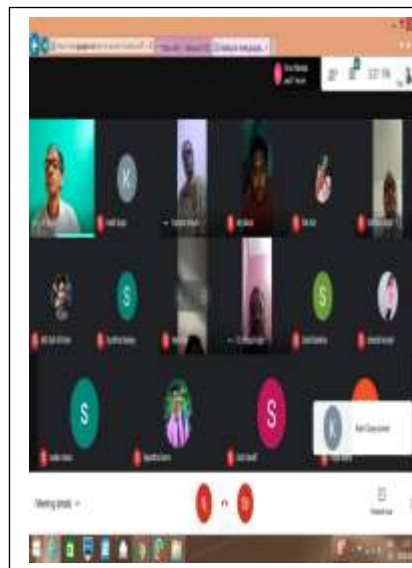
## **WEBINAR**

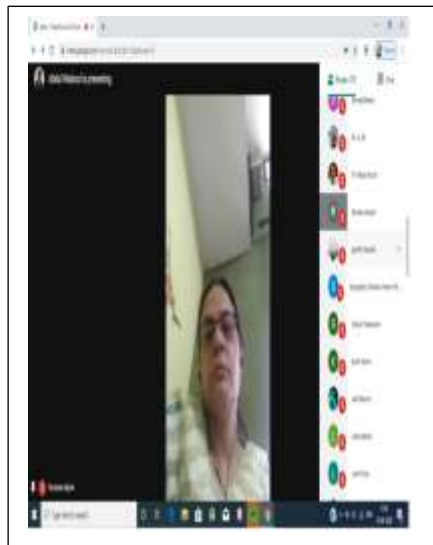
## **NATIONAL WEBINAR**

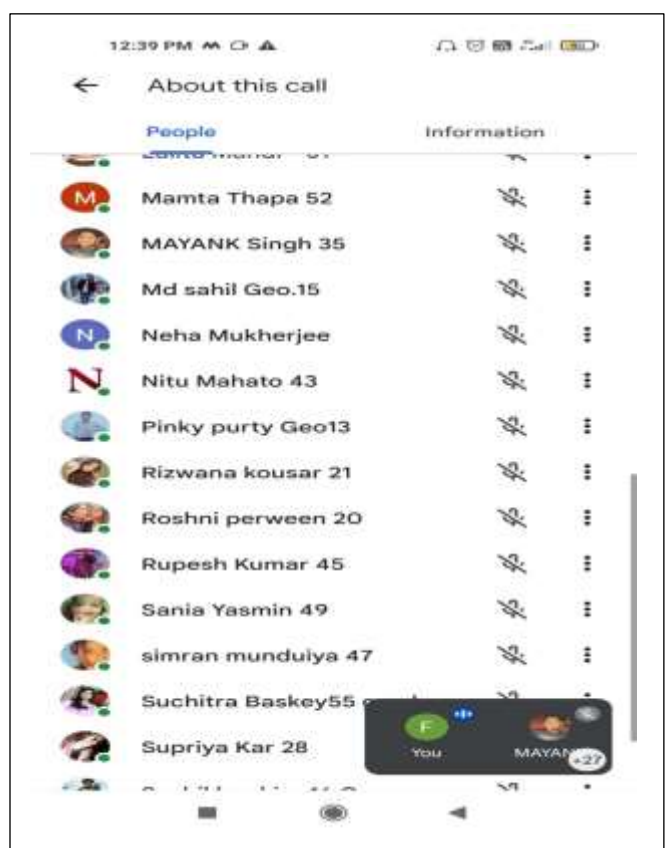
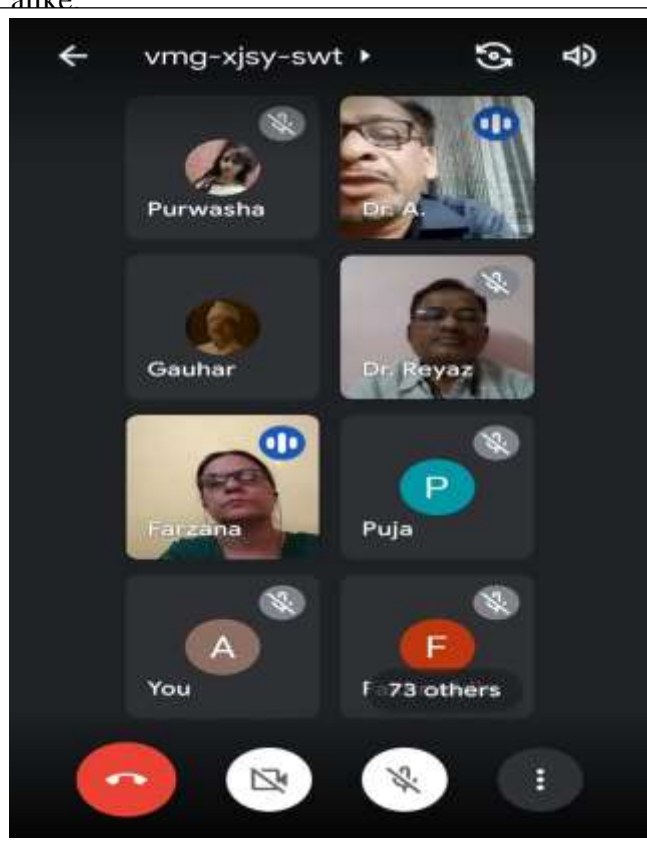
## WEBINAR

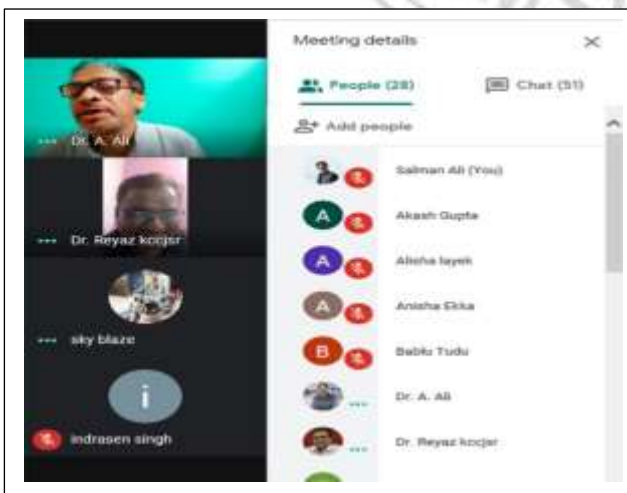


## CLASS TESTS: SEMESTER- V

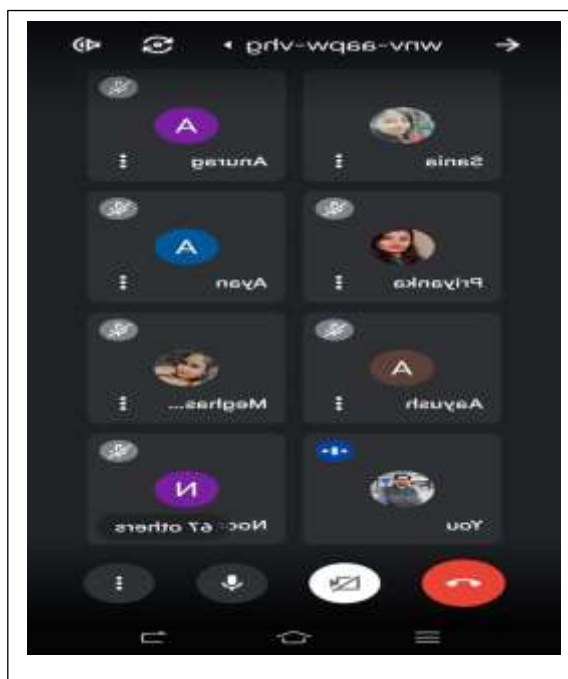
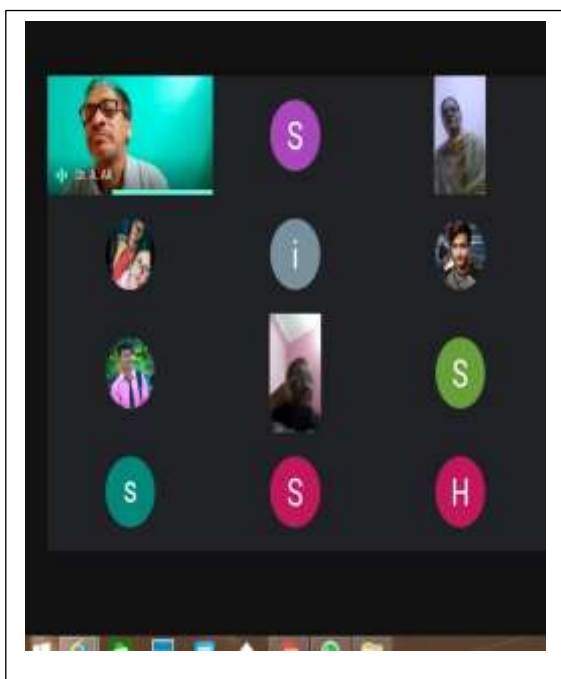




## **WEBINAR**

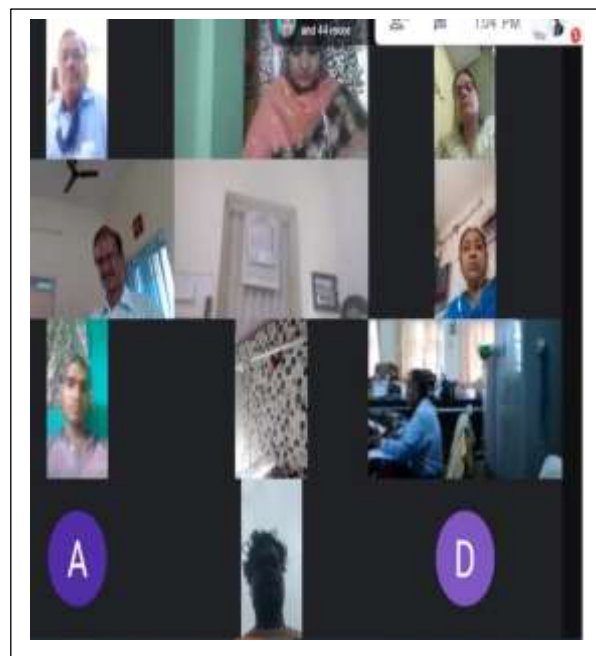

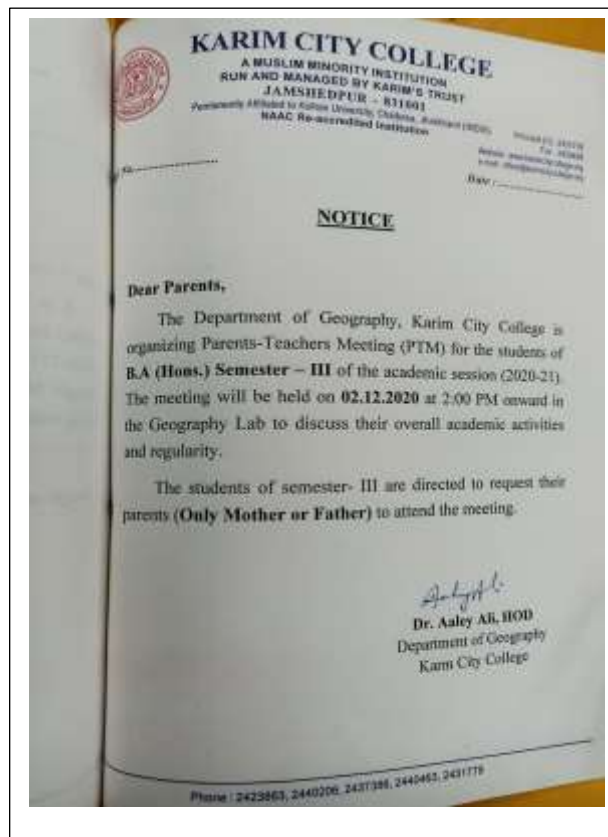
