Dr. Prabhat Kumar Pani passed B.Com. (Hons.) from St. Xavier's College, Ranchi under Ranchi University, Ranchi and M. Com. Degree from Sambalpur University, Orissa. The speaker explains the development of management education and detailed about management. 


The Programmed was structured in the four categories based on Entertainment, Games, Ramp Walk for Mr.& Ms. Fresher's of 2k23 and the DJ.
