The department has three separate, air-conditioned, state-of-the-art studios to provide training for the students in Shooting, editing, and Sound. The practical assignments have been designed to prepare them for the industry. The department has 15 computers with the latest configuration. The whole college campus is connected through a structured wired Local Area Network (LAN).

Placement


The placement of the students has been remarkable. Many students pursue higher studies after passing the entrance exams conducted by various universities. The rest join the media as professionals. They are working with almost all newspaper houses, TV channels, and radio stations.

Library

The college library is well organised, with more than 45,000 books. 20 magazines are regularly subscribed, along with six journals of national repute. Two books are issued to each student from the library. The books must be returned on or before the 14th day of issue. They can be reissued if the student so desires. A fine is collected in cases of delay in the return of books as per library rules. Apart from this, the department has a separate library with around 1000 books on media and journalism, along with a collection of more than 100 films. There is a reading room attached to the library for the students to study in their leisure periods. Books can be issued during working hours for reference. The library is computerised and has internet connectivity.







RULES

In order to have a harmonious atmosphere on campus and to ensure a peaceful academic environment, the College strictly adheres to some basic and fundamental principles and expects that students will abide by the rules and regulations devised by the College:

- Any indiscipline, misconduct, or disruptive activities on the part of the students will be strictly dealt with.
- Loitering during college hours and congregating in the corridors is strictly prohibited.
- In compliance with the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the college has implemented the
 recommendations of the "Raghavan Committee on Ragging in Educational Institutions". Hence, for any act of
 ragging by the students inside the campus that may lead to a violation of the order of the Hon'ble Supreme
 Court, stringent action may be taken against the offending students.
- Students are not allowed to stand in front of or near a class room when a teacher is engaging the class.
- Setup/Promotional tests are held on a regular basis, and students must appear in such examinations.
- It is expected of the students that they will be regulars in their classes. 75% attendance is compulsory for students to fill out the examination from the university. No special classes will be arranged to make up for the shortage in attendance.
- Every student of the college is provided with an Identity Card at the time of admission. Students must keep their Identity Card with them while on campus.

The college authorities may demand their Identity cards as and when they are required. In case of damage or loss, a new Identity Card will be issued to the student only after clearance from the disciplinary committee. For the reissue of an identity card, a student has to deposit a sum of Rs. 50/- only

- No Society, Association, Union, or Club will be formed in the name of the college without the prior permission of the Principal.
- No meeting shall be convened, and no person shall be invited to address any meeting without the prior permission of the Principal,
- Students are not allowed to participate in any political or religious activities on the college campus or outside, in the name of the college. Violating this rule will invite strict administrative action.
- Students are not permitted to collect money or any other donations inside or outside the campus in the name of the college.
- Chewing tobacco, Pan Masala, and Gutkha are strictly prohibited on campus.
- The use of cell phones on campus is a strong offence that leads to stringent action against the student.
- Students are supposed to show due respect, courtesy, and consideration to the teachers and other college staff. They must maintain a sense of compassion and brotherliness with their fellow students.
- The School/College Leaving Certificate deposited at the time of admission will not be returned. Hence, the students are advised to keep a sufficient number of photo copies such a such certificate.
- Character and Provisional certificates may be issued on payment of Rs. 50/- only.
- A CLC or TC will be issued on payment of Rs. 150/-. In case of theft or loss, a duplicate CLC or TC will be issued only after presentation of an affidavit by a notary and payment of Rs. 200/-.
- Students have to produce their identity card, Admit Card, Fee card, and other relevant testimonials at the time of applying for any certificate.
- Strict disciplinary action, to the extent of expulsion from the college, may be taken against anyone who does not abide by the rules and regulations laid down by the college authorities.
- Any legal matter related to the college will be dealt with within the jurisdiction of the Jamshedpur Courts only.

B.A IN MASS COMMUNICATION - VIDEO PRODUCTION


The department offers a graduation degree B.A. in Mass Communication - Video Production, recognized by UGC, New Delhi. To get enrolled in this programme, the aspirants must have Higher Secondary (10+2) Education, or an equivalent with any subject having a minimum score of 45%. The Bachelor's degree programme is a 3+1 years semester-based course, and each semester concludes with an end semester university examination. The pedagogy combines theory and practical in a balanced manner.

The degree programme aims to create professionals for the media, television, OTT, advertisement and film industries. It equips candidates with the excellent understanding of how-to-do-it, good communication and writing skills, necessary to create magic in the media & entertainment industry. It must be noted that a joint report by Boston Consulting Group (BCG) and Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), the India Media & Entertainment industry is estimated to be valued between USD 2729 billion in 2022 and is poised to grow to USD 5565 billion by 2030.

After successfully completing the Bachelor of Mass Communication - Video Production programme, one can have excellent career opportunities in journalism and mass media in the private and public sectors, like advertising agencies, film production, public relations, corporate communication, newspapers, television channels, and central information services. Editors, columnists, correspondents, photojournalists, reporters, new analysts, proofreaders, lecturers, etc. are all examples of people who identify as journalists. A candidate can work as a news producer for TV, researcher, scriptwriter, and anchor, among other jobs. She/he can also find work in audio engineering and video editing. She/he can work as camera operators, assistant producers, or in other positions in the film industry. She/he can be employed in the radio industry as a Radio Jockey, programme Producers, and Audio Engineers.

Library and Reading Room

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The College Library has a large number of text books and reference books to support the educational needs of the students and every year a considerable number of books keep on being added to the stock. Under the guidance of Library In-charge Dr. Md. Moiz Ashraf sincere efforts are made throughout the year to keep the library updated and student-friendly. Presently, the college has around 56,319 books, 4200 e-books and subscribes to 85 journals and 23 periodicals. With the assistance of UGC, New Delhi, Book Bank scheme has been introduced for needy and meritorious students. Under this scheme, text books are issued to the students for one academic session. All the books of the library are bar-coded and are issued electronically to the students. In keeping up with its user-centered efforts, the college Library has successfully installed E-cataloguing system. The college Library is connected with INFLIBNET through which students and faculty members may utilize hundreds of e-books and e-journals, both national and international.

The college Library has reading room facilities which the students may use for their academic pursuits. The reading room remains open during the college hours. Students are expected to utilize this and other facilities of the library to the optimum level. Students, while availing of the library facilities, are expected to follow certain rules:

The library remains open from 8.00 a.m. to 9.00 p.m. However, due to heavy work load, separate timing is fixed for the issue of books

Two books can be issued to a student at a time for a period of two weeks.

College ID card serves as the library card which has to be produced by the student at the issue counter for borrowing books.

Strict silence must be maintained in the Reading Room and at the issue counter. Nothing should be done by way of smoking, spitting or otherwise, which may run contrary to the decorum and discipline of the library.

Virtual Library & Talking Books

The College has introduced the concept of E-learning by establishing a Virtual library in the offline mode. E-books and E-journals are available which can be accessed by the students. The students may also upload books or study materials for the benefits of others.

The College library also provides a huge consortium of e-books through the student app. The college library will continuously upload books as well as scanned copies of printed books through its library management system. This will be made available to the students through Master Soft Cloud (student app) which will also offer the facility of uploading notes both by the teachers, E-notices, e-routines etc.

In order to facilitate visually challenged the college has procured software through which printed books can be converted into talking books. Students can make the computer read the hard copies and can also make a record of it. Separate booth, accommodative of two students at one time has been installed in the virtual library.

Common Rooms & Gymnasium

The College has separate Common Rooms for Boys and Girls having facilities like Table Tennis. Carom Board, Chess, Ludo. Chinese Checkers etc. Magazines and Newspapers are also provided to them. Dr. Shahid Ahmad Hashmi, Department of Mathematics and Dr. Kauser Tasneem. Department of History are the in-charges of common room (boys) and common room (girls) respectively. Indoor games championship is organized every year for the students. A gymnasium has been established at the Student Activity Centre which offers membership to our students at a very nominal fee.

Xerox and Printing Facility

The college has introduced Xerox & Printing Facility for the students and staff members so that text books, reference books and relevant study materials can be photo copied, or printed at subsidized rate.

Net Surfing and free Wi-Fi Facilities

Free net surfing facilities are available to the students in the Virtual library and to the staff members in the lab of Department of Computer Applications. The college also provides free Wi-Fi services to all its students and staff.

Scholarship, Stipend & Free Studentship

Applications for Stipends received from the students belonging to Schedule castes, Schedule Tribes and Backward Classes are recommended by the college for realization of their fees to the District Welfare Department. At the time of admission, students belonging to these categories shall have to produce caste and income Certificates duly issued by the Additional Deputy Collector or Revenue Officer. No Certificates will be accepted after Admission. The college provides guidance and support to the students to apply at NSP (National Scholarship Portal) and for other government scholarships.

The college also offers financial assistance to the needy students through its own resources. For this the college has introduced merit cum means scholarships, Syed Tafazzul Karim Scholarship for boys and Mehrunnisa Scholarship for girls have been given to meritorious and needy students. On the ground of poverty and merit, free Studentship up to 12.5% of the total number of students on the college roll is given. Besides, the college awards book grants and other help to needy students.

Canteen and Parking Space

The college canteen remains open during working days serving light snacks and other eatables at a reasonable price. It is, however, expected from the students that they will use this facility judiciously and do not waste their precious time in long conversations or misdemeanor in the college canteen. Space has been provided in the college campus to park bicycles but no responsibility lies with the college in case of theft or damage.






