Session: 2019-2020

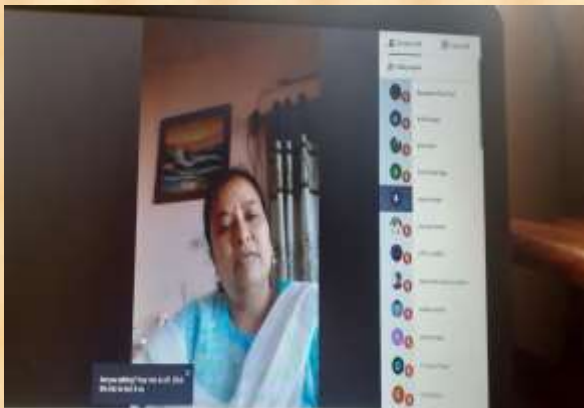
