SPArC (Society for Promotion of Art and Culture) of Karim City College organized its induction for the year 2020-2021 on 12 December, 2020.




SPArC of Karim City College organized a competition of self composed poetry recitation on 22, February 2021.







Aaeena-e-Shab 15.06.21






In this era of lockdown, where the opening of schools and colleges now seems like a dream, it seems even more difficult to organize a program successfully.



In order to keep students connected with literature and culture, a Mushaira




The first attempt by the Book Club of SPArC, Karim City College, to make students book friendly was successful.






World Tribal Day 09.08.21








The event was not just a book launch but a morning to celebrate, admire and praise Akhtar Azad's passion towards Urdu literature, and Dr.Zaki Anwar.




