Annual Report: 2018 -2019

The 2018 – 2019 academic session began in August 2018 with a general induction program. During this event, the principal and various faculty members addressed the new batch of students, introducing them to the faculty, campus activities, regulations, and the overall culture of the campus.

Activities:

- **Department Induction:** the department conducted its own Induction session for students on Monday, August 13th, introducing them to the department's history, annual academic and co-curricular activities, faculty, senior student batches, syllabus structure, course allocation among faculty, and recommended reading list.
- **Parent Teacher meeting:** On January 10th, 2018, a parent-teacher meeting was convened for B.Sc. Part 1 (Hons) students to discuss their wards' performance in attendance, discipline, and class test results
- **Educational tour:**
 - On January 27th, 2019, an educational excursion to Digha was arranged, with 32 students from B.Sc. Part-III (Hons) participating. During the trip, they received insights into marine life, including fishes and animals, and also collected zoological specimens for the Department.
 - Additionally, on February 22nd, 2019, students from B.Sc. Part-1(Hons) Sem-1 visited the Zoological Park in Jamshedpur for an educational visit
- **National science day:** On March 3rd, 2019, B.Sc. Part 1 (Hons), B.Sc. Part II (H), and B.Sc. Part III(H) students observed National Science Day. The event was attended by all faculty members and teachers from other science departments.
- **Class test:** Class tests and quizzes were conducted periodically to assess students' understanding of covered topics and to provide instructors with insights into students' comprehension levels of the subject matter.
- **Fresher party:** On September 15th, a Fresher's Party, hosted by senior students, welcomed the new batch of juniors, attended by the principal, department faculty, and teachers from other departments, featuring various activities including an extempore competition to select Miss and Master Fresher
- **Farewell:** On the 5th of March, a farewell party was arranged by the junior students for their senior counterparts in the department, with coordination from the faculty members. The event was characterized by its high entertainment value and marked success
