



Abstract: The main objective of this research article is to measure and compare the level of membershall and social support among the tribal and non-tribal students of east singhbhum district. A total plant and social support among the tribal and 100 non-tribal) college students were included. The sample 200 college students' split (100 tribal and 100 non-tribal) college students were included. The sample was chosen used a purposive sampling technique. Social Support Scale by Dhull and Godara (201) and Mental Health Inventory (M.H.I.) developed by Jagdish and Srivastava was utilized for the day collection. 't' test was using to see the significance of difference between two groups and sub group based on ethnicity and gender. Correlation coefficient was applied to check the relationship between mental health and social support. The result of the result revealed that there is a positive and significant mental health and social support. Further the result reported that male college relationship between mental health and social support as do female college students. The result and students have much better mental health and social support as do female college students. The result and found that non-tribal college students are better than their equivalent in terms of mental health and military college students in social support.
