




Then Dr. Mohammad Reyaz , the principal of Karim City College gave a speech by congratulating the students of Geography Department to get a beautiful



The principal of Karim City College, Dr. Mohammad Reyaz was also present as the guest speaker on that occasion. Firstly the assisstant professor of Geography Department, Dr. Pasarul Islam welcomed the gathering beautifully. Then later, Head of Department of Geography, Dr. Aaley Ali acknowledged the students about population, that it is the group of individuals with shared citizenship, identity or characteristics. A population is a representative sample of a larger group of people. Government conducts census to quantify the size of a resident population within a given jurisdiction.



Then the principal of Karim City College, Dr. Mohammad Reyaz addressed the gathering by wishing everyone World Population Day. He said as we all know that the number of people who live in a particular area, city or country is called population. We celebrated World Population Day on July 11th every



World Ozone Day

Date: 16th Sep, 2023

The Department of Geography, Karim City College, Jamshedpur has organized a Students Seminar on World Ozone Day on 16th of September 2023. The principal of Karim City College, Dr. Mohammad Reyaz was also present in the seminar. Firstly the Head of Department of Geography, Dr. Aaley Ali welcomed the gathering beautifully. Then later he acknowledged the students about the World Ozone Day that it is celebrated to inform people about the significance of the Ozone layer along with how its depletion can have adverse effects on human health ecosystems and the environment and suggest measures for its recovery. World Ozone day is international day for the preservation of the ozone layer. Then the principal of Karim City College, Dr. Mohammad Reyaz addressed the gathering by wishing everyone World Ozone Day.





He said as we all know that the Ozone is an odorless, colorless gas made up of three oxygen molecules (O_3) and is a natural part of the environment. It occurs both in the earth upper atmosphere or stratosphere and at ground level in the lower atmosphere or troposphere. He said that the ozone layer depletion is the thinning of the ozone layer present in the upper atmosphere. This happens when the chlorine and bromine atoms in the atmosphere come in contact with Ozone and destroy the Ozone molecules. The stratospheric ozone layer is Earth's 'sunscreen' which is protecting living things from too much ultraviolet radiation from the Sun. The ozone layer absorbs 97% to 99% of the sun's incoming ultraviolet radiation. Long-term exposure to UV radiation threatens human life, causing skin cancer, eye diseases and other health problems and seriously harms animals plants and microbes. Avoid the consumption of gases dangerous to the ozone layer can be a good measure to prevent the ozone depletion.





The student of semester 1, Avinash Hansda talked about the importance of celebrating World Ozone Day. Then Misba Ali of semester -1 informed about the main importance of ozone layer. The Ozone layer in the stratosphere absorbs a portion of the radiation from the Sun, preventing it from reaching the planet's surface. Then the student of semester -2 Rocky Das talked about the formation of Ozone. Ozone forms when sunlight breaks apart oxygen



molecules (O2) and free oxygen atoms then bond with other O2 molecules forming O3. Ozone is destroyed when it reacts with other molecules such as nitrogen, hydrogen, chlorine and bromine. Then later, Raunak Kabra of semester-4 talked about the solutions to Ozone Depletion. Ozone layer depletion is a huge issue for the atmosphere as well as all living things on the planet, including the flora and fauna. Minimizing the use of vehicles because these vehicles emit a large amount of greenhouse gases. Government should ban the use of nitrous oxide and pesticides. Then Sabiha Gul of semester-6 spoke about the effects of ozone depletion. It causes UV rays to reach the Earth and causes harm to living organisms like plants, animals and human. It can lead to skin cancer and cataract in humans. The UV rays from the sun will damage the DNA and lead to mutation. Falak Naaz of semester-2 conducted the seminar. Lastly, the assistant professor of Geography Department, Dr. Pasarul Islam concluded the webinar by giving a vote of thanks and showed gratitude towards everyone for their beautiful presence in the webinar.


Farewell Party

Student's Seminar on Weather Forecasting

Date: 20th December, 2023

The Department of Geography, Karim City College, Jamshedpur has organized Students Seminar on Weather Forecasting on 20th of December 2023. The seminar was programmed to know the importance and process of Weather Forecasting. Firstly the seminar was started with the speech of Head of Department of Geography, Dr. Aaley Ali. He acknowledged everyone about the weather Forecasting that it is actually predicting the weather by the use of science and technology. He also said that how weather forecasting is protecting lives and property everyday by giving weather warnings. Then the speech of Principal of Karim City College Dr. Mohammad Reyaz apprised the students that how weather forecasting helps determine future climate expectations. There are computer models and instruments which are used in this process. Weather Forecasting is helpful in the field of agriculture, to traders, students as well as to the common people. He said how we started predicting the weather from the 650 BC, when the Babylonians predicted by watching cloud patterns. Now the latest technology to predict weather is High Resolution Forecast (HRES) which uses mathematical model.

Then students also prepared power point presentation and speech regarding Weather Forecasting. Riya Kumari and Misba Ali of semester-1 presented presentation about the Instruments of Weather Forecasting. There are various instruments like anemometer, barometer, thermometer, wind vane etc. which made easy to predict the atmospheric conditions. Then, Rituparna Mahato of



semester-1 talked about the elements of weather forecasting. She said that there are six elements of weather: temperature, atmospheric pressure, wind, humidity, precipitation and cloudiness. Process of Weather Forecasting is incomplete without the continuous measuring of these elements. Then Rocky Das of semester-2 talked about the types of weather forecasting. In which Short, Medium and Long Range Forecasts are included.

Then the assistant professor, Dr. Farzana Anjum acknowledged the students about the process and techniques used in Jharkhand for weather forecasting. She also said that predicting the weather is a process involving many different methods that meteorologists also known as Weather Forecasters and scientists used to do with the help of technology. After that, Khushi Kumari of semester-2 spoke about the importance of weather forecasting. She said that how it is useful for adjustment of crop harvest timings, to know earlier about rainfall, cyclones, droughts, floods etc. It can also helpful in protecting lives and property, for traders etc. Afterwards, Meghashree Giri of semester-4 talked about the history of weather forecasting. Back in 650 BC, Babylonians predicted weather by looking at cloud patterns. Then many scientists invented different instruments and weather models. Now, the method of nowcasting is done by the help of radar images and computer models. Lastly, the assistant professor of Geography Department, Dr. Pasarul Islam concluded the seminar on a beautiful note by giving a vote of thanks. He showed gratitude towards everyone for their beautiful presence in the seminar.












Weather Forecasting Webinar Date: 14th January 2024

The webinar was organized with the motive of knowing about the Process and Applications of Weather Forecasting. The assistant professor of Department of Geography of North Bengal ST. Xavier's College of Jalpaiguri, West Bengal, Dr. Subrata Roy was present as a chief guest in the webinar. The principal of Karim City College, Dr. Mohammad Reyaz was also present in the webinar.





Firstly, the webinar was started with the speech cum introduction of Weather Forecasting by the Head of Department of Geography, Dr. Aaley Ali. He said that Weather Forecasting is actually predicting the weather by the use of science and technology. He also said that how weather forecasting is protecting lives and property everyday by giving weather warnings. Then the principal, Dr. Mohammad Reyaz gave welcome address to everyone, both teachers and students present in that webinar. He gave special thanks to the chief guest, Dr. Subrata Roy for attending the webinar. He also congratulated Geography Department for organising such interesting webinars.

Then the chief guest of the webinar, Dr. Subrata Roy started acknowledging students about the Weather Forecasting. He started from differentiating weather and climate. Weather refers to the short-term conditions of the atmosphere and climate refers to the long-term patterns and averages over a region. He said that simple prediction of weather for next few days is termed as Weather Forecasting. It is the application of science and technology to predict the conditions of the atmosphere for a given location and time. He also explained that these weather predictions are actually done by the gathering objective data about the condition of atmosphere at a certain location and using technology, applications of science and Meteorology to predict how the weather will behave in the future. He also said that prediction of weather is not always accurate because of the chaotic nature of the atmosphere. He apprised the students about the history and types of the Weather Forecasting.





He beautifully covers all the topics including elements, tools as well as scope of weather forecasting. He also educated everyone about how useful the weather forecasting actually is. It is useful to know earlier about the bad weather to protect lives and property. Then the assistant professor, Dr. Pasarul Islam did the questions-answers session by completing the doubts and queries of the students. 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Workshop on Celestial and Meteorological Observation Date: 17th January 2024

The Department of Geography, Karim City College, Jamshedpur organized an insightful Workshop focused on Celestial and Meteorological Observation on 17th of January, 2024. The workshop aimed to enhance the understanding of weather forecasting techniques and instruments among students. The Geography Department marked the 15th year of the establishment of the Meteorological Observatory in the college campus. This workshop is part of the college's contribution to India's celebration of the 150th year of the Indian Meteorological Department (IMD). Dr. Mohammad Reyaz, the Principal of Karim City College, extended his good wishes for the success of the programme. He said that the great hard work and dedication of the Geography Department is commendable.





Then the head of Department of Geography, Dr. Aaley Ali conducted the workshop and talked about Meteorological Observation. It is basically an evaluation of one or more weather elements that describe the state of atmosphere. He explained that Meteorology is the science of atmosphere in simple terms. Then he said predicting the weather is called Weather Forecasting. Weather forecasting gives information about the future weather conditions based upon the collection and analysis of Meteorological Observations. Then he gave information about the importance of weather forecasting that it saves lives and property. It is also good for farmers, traders and travellers to know earlier about the bad weather. He also acknowledged students about the techniques of weather forecasting that meteorologists use instruments from thermometers and Barometer to weather balloons and computer models and satellites for weather prediction. Radar is also a important instrument. He was also showing many instruments which are used for monitoring celestial bodies in which Telescope, Sundial, Thermometer, Wind Vane, GPS, Anemometer, Binoculars, Barometer, Rain Gauge and Eclipse



glasses etc. He also explained that how these instruments works and why they are useful in the process of Weather Forecasting. Then the assistant professor of Geography Department, Dr. Farzana Anjum apprised the students about the elements of weather one by one in which temperature, atmospheric pressure, wind, humidity, precipitation and cloudiness are included. Then Dr. Pasarul Islam, assistant professor of Geography Department talked about how weather forecasting was used to done in ancient times and how it is processing now. He said how we started predicting the weather from the 650 BC, when the babylonians predicted by watching cloud patterns. Now the latest technology to predict weather is High Resolution Forecast (HRES) which uses mathematical models.

Visit to Atomic Mineral Directorate (AMD)

The Department of Geography, Karim City College organised an excursion by visiting the Atomic Mineral Directorate of Exploration and Research (AMD) on 8th of February, 2024. The laboratory of AMD is situated at Khas Mahal, Karandi. The main programme of AMD is to identify and evaluate uranium resources required for the successful implementation of Atomic Energy programme in India. The main purpose of the excursion is to acknowledge the students about the requirements and benefits of Nuclear Power Programme in India.





Firstly, there was a seminar lecture about the Nuclear Energy, its uses and advantages. The seminar lecture was taking place in the Homi J. Bhabha Auditorium. The professors explained the students about hoe the uranium is actually extracted from the minerals through audio-visual content. The students saw Uranium sensors and detectors in the Physics Department of AMD. The process of calculation of atomic minerals in rocks where shown to the students in microscope in the Geology labs. The method of survey on fields and the classification of rocks were also shown to the students by the geologists. There were so many rocks of contrasting colors and elements placed in the laboratories. They showed us a visual demonstration to compare nuclear energy with thermal energy was done through presentations. Then, lastly they showed the chemical classification of rocks through advanced machines. The students of semester 1 and 2 were went to this visit and they came a lot of new things about the advantages and application of Nuclear Energy.


Webinar Series No:1 On

World Water Day


Date: 22nd March 2024



The stage was conducted by Geeta Kumari and the vote of thanks was given by Syed Sajid Parwaiz.




Webinar on World Ocean Day Date: 8th June 2024
