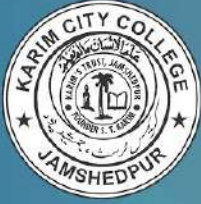

ABOUT THE COURSE

Welcome to the 30-hour Value Added Online Certificate Course on Introduction to Literature offered by Karim City College's Post Graduate Department of English in Jamshedpur. Participants who complete the course will get a course completion certificate, recognizing their dedication and achievement in acquiring core knowledge and abilities in literature.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Develop a comprehensive understanding of literature's meaning, relevance, and numerous literary aspects in order to improve participants' critical thinking skills and appreciation for literature.

Introduce participants to a variety of literary genres, such as poetry, drama, fiction, and nonfiction, in order to broaden their literary knowledge and build a greater appreciation for the richness and diversity of English literature.

03

Enable participants to critically interact with intricate themes, characters, and narrative structures in English literature by developing their analytical and interpretative abilities via the study of literary texts from a variety of genres.

04

Develop an understanding of the elements that influence the production and reception of literature, prompting participants to explore the factors, contexts and elements that shape literary texts and their representations.

05

Provide participants with the knowledge and skills needed to read literary analysis, enabling them to assess and analyze literary works critically within the context of larger cultural, historical, and theoretical frameworks.

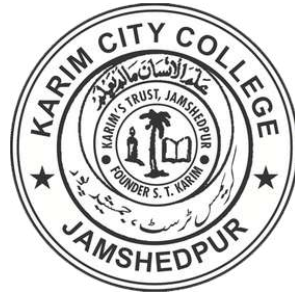
