NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In pursuance of the said agreement observed and performed, THE COLLEGE HEREBY DEMISES UNTO THE TRAINING SERVICE PROVIDER ALL THAT the allocated area(s) in the building situated at (Karim City College, Sakchi campus, Jamshedpur, Pin code-831001) and hereinafter called as the demised premises. TOGETHER WITH ALL the fixtures and fitting therein, TOGETHER WITH the separate electricity sub-meter, electrical installations and together with the right for the Training Service Provider, its employees, servants, agents, customers and persons authorized by the College to use the entrances, doorways, entrance hall, staircases, landings and passages in the demised premises for the purpose of ingress thereto.
2. Agreement shall begin on the (Commencement Date) and end on the (End Date), hereinafter known as the "User Rights Term". The Training Service Provider shall have the right to terminate this Agreement at any time by providing at least 60 days' written notice to the College for an early termination. Upon termination of the said agreement the Training Service Provider may re-enter or renew the contract for next term with the College as per mutual consent and agreement
3. The Training Service Provider hereby covenants with the College as follows:
 - a. To pay the electricity bills for the electricity consumed for lighting the demised premises and for operation of air conditioners, fans, computers and electrical appliances in the demised premises as per the sub meter installed. This would be applicable only after setting up and functioning of Domain Training Laboratory by the Training Service Provider.
 - b. The facilitator will deduct 10% or 15% (10% from Colleges located in the rural area and 15% from Colleges located in the urban area) of the payable Training Fee from the Training Service Provider due to making the building and premises available for the skill development purpose and deposit the same amount in the account of the College, towards development and maintenance of building infrastructure and also electricity bills of the demised building and the premises till the Training Service Provider conducts only Employability Skills training program.

- c. The Training Service Provider shall be entitled to erect fittings, fixtures, wooden partitions, cabins or make any such additions or alterations, as may be necessary for its use by the Training Service Provider ; provided that the Training Service Provider shall remove the said fittings, fixtures, wooden partitions, cabins, additions or alterations and restore the demised premises to the College on the expiry of the term of sooner determination of the User Rights in the same condition as existed before making such changes.
 - d. To use the demised premises for office purposes of the Training Service Provider.
 - e. College is authorizing the Training Service Provider for branding and promotional activity in the premise as and when required.
 - f. To permit the College, his servants, employees or agents duly authorized by him to enter into and upon the demised premises at all reasonable times for viewing the condition of the demised premises or doing such works or things as may be requisite or necessary for any repairs, alterations, servicing or improvements to the demised premises.
4. This User Rights Deed shall be executed in Triplicate. The original shall be retained by the College, the duplicate by the Training Service Provider and the triplicate by the Facilitator.
5. The marginal notes and the catch lines hereto are meant only for convenience of references and shall not in any way be taken into account in the interpretation of their presents.
6. Dispute Resolution:

This Agreement shall be governed according to the Indian laws and each Party shall submit to the jurisdiction of the Courts at Delhi, IndiaAny and all differences and disputes whatsoever arising between the Parties concerning the interpretation of this agreement or in relation to the subject matter contained in this agreement shall, in the first instance, be resolved mutually between the Parties and in the

event of non-resolution, the matter shall be referred to arbitration by a Sole Arbitrator to be conducted in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The seat of arbitration shall be Delhi. The conduct of arbitration proceedings shall be in English and the award passed by the sole arbitrator shall be binding on all parties. Unless otherwise decided by the arbitrator/s, the cost of arbitration shall be shared by the Parties in equal proportion

7. Force Majeure:

The Parties hereto agree that a Force Majeure Event shall mean any unforeseeable act or event that prevents the affected Party from performing its obligations under this Agreement or complying with any conditions required by the other Party under this Agreement and such act or event is beyond the reasonable control and not because of any fault of the affected Party and such Party has been unable to avoid such an act or event by the exercise of prudent foresight and due diligence. Neither Party hereto shall be considered in breach hereof or in default if it fails to perform or observe any or all of the terms of this Agreement resulting directly or indirectly, from Force Majeure Events such as acts of God, Civil or Military authority, acts of Government, acts of Public Enemy, war, riots, explosion, earthquake, flood, storm, lightning strike, etc. In such a case the affected Party shall notify the other Party of the occurrence of such Force Majeure Event and should consequently, the performance under this Agreement be prevented for a period longer than 30 days, then the other Party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement

8. Compliance with Laws:

The Parties shall at all times and at its own expense

- a) strictly comply with all applicable laws, rules, regulations and Governmental orders, now or hereafter in effect, relating to its performance of this Agreement.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The shared objective of this partnership, in compliance with the NAAC audit concerning Solid and Electronic Waste rules is to provide solutions for effective collection and channelization of Solid Waste, including Sanitary and E- waste is signed on this Date May 2022. The Zero Waste Project with KCC institution shall span for 3 years.

KORU Foundation Deliverables

Energy Audit, Green Audit and Water Audit for NAAC purpose
Implementation of Zero waste model in the Institution :

- Awareness of students, teaching, non teaching staffs and workers on source segregation, restrict use of single use plastics and sustainable lifestyle towards Waste Free Campus
- Education and Implementation on Solid waste and water management (Waste water filtration, Rain water harvesting)
- Showing real time impact by channelizing dry waste to Recycling facilities
- Constructing small Bio-gas infrastructure for cooked food waste
- Compost – garden waste
- Expert advice on improvement of Rain Water harvesting system, Energy Conservation, Solar Energy Implementation

Karim City College Deliverables

- Provide students active support mainly from NCC, NSS, Department of Botany, Zoology and Geography in Koru Foundation's campaigns and other events mainly – Cleaning drives includes waste clean-up from land and water bodies, Landscaping including Tree plantations.
- Support from KCC mass media students as per need in Koru Foundation's communication material like videography, editing, and social media marketing
- Support from the College students in ensuring the sustainability of Zero waste model implementation in the campus.

Termination

Karim City College or KORU Foundation can terminate this MOU by giving a written notice of 30 days in advance citing reasonable grounds for such action. However, none of the organizations are entitled to claim any compensation for such premature termination , if with reasonable sufficient grounds.

A. Description of Parties

Karim City College (KCC), was established in 1961 by the Founder Late Syed Tafazzul Karim with a view to impart education to the weaker section of Jamshedpur has now become a premier educational institution of eastern India. It is permanently affiliated to Kolhan University, Chaibasa, Jharkhand.

Located in the heart of the city, the College possesses a student friendly infrastructure, education centre activities and knowledge-oriented ambience. Karim City College offers UG and PG level courses in five faculties with 22 departments. Karim City College is known for its discipline, quality services and dedication. Academic excellence is a pursuit and college has been accredited by NAAC.

And

BA College of Engineering & Technology (BACET), Jamshedpur, is a fast-growing technical institution established in the year 2007, approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi as well as Dept. of Higher & Technical Education, Govt. of Jharkhand and affiliated to Jharkhand University of Technology (JUT), Ranchi. BACET is running following courses:

- a. 4-years undergraduate engineering (B. Tech.) courses in five branches namely Mechanical Engineering (ME), Electrical & Electronics Engineering (EEE), Electronics & Communication Engineering (ECE), Computer Science & Engineering (CSE), and Civil Engineering (CE).
- b. 3-years Diploma Engineering Course in Mechanical Engineering (ME), Electrical (EE), and Civil Engineering (CE).
- c. 3-years Professional Courses in Bachelors of Business Administration (BBA) and Bachelors of Computer Applications (BCA).



BA College of Engineering & Technology (BACET), Jamshedpur and Karim City College Jamshedpur recognize their strengths and agree for academic cooperation in the areas of their mutual interest, and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding (MoU).

B. Objectives and Scope of Collaboration

The objective / goal of this MoU is to foster collaboration and to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best effort, mutual benefit, and frequent interactions. BACET and KCC agree to:

- a. exchange information on research and educational programmes,
- b. exchange best practices,
- c. exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes,
- d. exchange of faculties and students,
- e. career counselling of students,
- f. curriculum development,
- g. jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty / students to participate therein,
- h. skill-based certification courses relevant to both the parties,
- i. jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty /students to participate therein,
- j. jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty / students to participate therein,
- k. exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students / faculties at Undergraduate, Graduate and Doctoral levels for limited periods of time for purpose of education and /or research,
- l. explore ways to share teaching/learning material, and other relevant literature, while respecting each other's intellectual property and other rights,
- m. help in identifying and inviting faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between BACET and KCC,
- n. Organize and accelerate innovation, entrepreneurship and incubation programs,
- o. Other areas of cooperation as mutually agreed by BACET and KCC.

C. Intellectual Property

BACET and KCC agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

D. Financial Commitments / Cost

Each Party shall bear its own cost and expenses incurred in connection with the performance of its obligations under this MOU.



E. Co-ordination

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf, periodically review the progress and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

F. Validity / Tenure of MoU and Termination


This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for five years, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once terminated, neither BACET nor KCC will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, BACET and KCC will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

G. Arbitration Clause

Should there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Chairman / Principal BACET and Principal KCC will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.




