A REPORT

The Department of English, Karim City College, Jamshedpur, organised a three-day International Web Conference on "Translation and the Glocal- Texts, Identity, Politics and Cultural Survival" from 27th to 29th August 2020, in which academicians from India and abroad participated.

DAY 1 (27.08.2020)

(a) Inaugural Session (10.30 am IST)

The Session was initiated by Dr. Neha Tiwari, Asst. Professor Dept. of English, Karim City College, Jamshedpur. Prof. (Dr.) Gangadhar Panda, Vice-Chancellor, Kolhan University, Chaibasa, Jharkhand, inaugurated the Conference. Dr. Mohammad Reyaz, Prof-in-Charge, Karim City College, Jamshedpur, delivered the Welcome Address, and congratulated the Dept. of English, Karim City College, for arranging such an important Conference. Dr. S.M Yahiya Ibrahim, Head, Dept. of English, Karim City College, Jamshedpur and Convenor of the Conference said that there are two realms of translation in our lives, viz, the realm of Education and that of Social Translation. He said that in the realm of translation the language and linguistic skill are of utmost importance. He referred to Rabindranath Tagore and other Indian scholars and opined that India is a big laboratory for translation and as such translation assumes great importance in this country.
