Teachers Feedback Report

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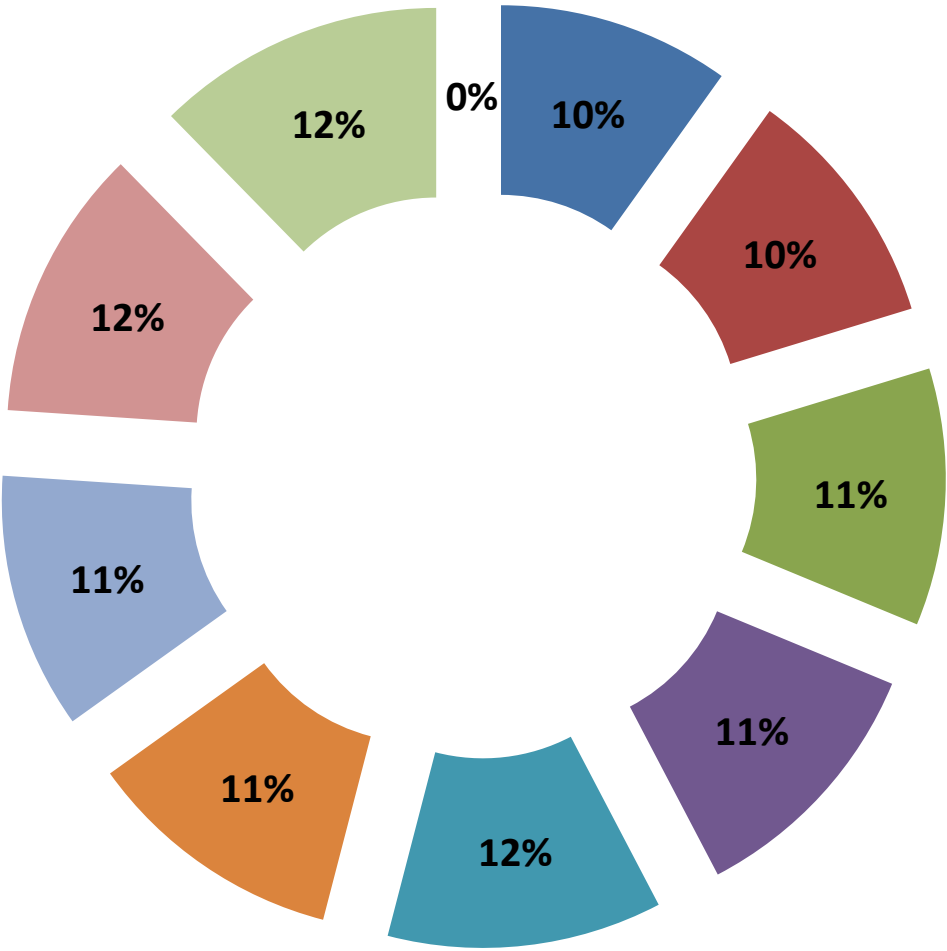
Teacher's Feedback Report for Session 2019-20

IQAC recorded feedback of teachers as part of feedback documentation of stakeholders from 58 teachers of 18 departments of the college for the session 2019-20. The feedback has been recorded online through Google form with 10 questions. The teachers were given a scale of 0 to 4 in which 0 stands for 'unsatisfied', 1 stands for 'satisfactory', 2 for 'good', 3 for 'very good' and 4 for 'excellent'.

- The teachers were asked to rate the level of satisfaction with reference to their job. The average of the answer received is **2.91**. The average shows that the teachers have rated it as **good**.
- The teachers were asked to answer whether they find a fine balance between theory and its application in the syllabi of the courses. The average of the answers received is **3.07**. It shows that teachers have rated the balance **every good**.
- The teachers were requested to rate the facilities available in the college. The average of the feedbacks received is **3.23**. It shows that the teachers have rated the facilities of the college as **very good**.
- The teachers were enquired whether the college provides adequate opportunities and support for upgrading qualification and work skills. The average of the feedbacks received is **3.26**. The average shows that most of the teachers have rated college as **very good** in terms of providing adequate opportunities and support for upgrading qualification and work skills.
- The teachers were questioned whether the textbooks, reference books, and journals available in the library are relevant and constantly updated. The average of the feedbacks received is **3.5**. The average shows that the teachers find it more than **very good** and leading towards excellence.

- The teachers were asked on the availability of ICT support and online facilities for teaching and learning are conducive to their job. The average of the feedbacks received is **3.26**. The average shows that the teachers find the college **very good** with regards to the availability of ICT support and online facilities for teaching and learning.
- The teachers were enquired about freedom with regard to pedagogy and adoption of new techniques in teaching-learning and assessment by the college authorities. The average of the feedbacks received is **3.22**. The average shows that the teachers have rated college **very good** with regard to freedom in pedagogy and adoption of new techniques in teaching-learning and assessment by the college authorities.
- The teachers were asked whether the authorities are sensitive, helpful and friendly. The average of the feedbacks received is **3.42**. The teachers have rated the authorities as sensitive, helpful and friendly as the average are more than 3. It denoted that they find them **very good**.
- The teachers were asked whether the management and governance of the college are visionary and growth-oriented. The average of the answers received in the feedbacks is **3.63**. The average shows that the teachers have rated the college management as **very good** in being visionary and growth-oriented.
