TABISH KHAIR was born and educated in India, and now lives in Denmark, where he is a professor at Aarhus University. His recent novels include *How to Fight Islamist Terror from the Missionary Position* (HarperCollins, Interlink and Corsair 2014), *Just Another Jihadi Jane* (Penguin/Periscope 2016; Interlink 2017) and *Night of Happiness* (Picador, 2018). Translated into various languages (including three novels in Italian), Khair has won or been shortlisted for around 20 poetry, fiction and non-fiction prizes in seven countries. He has held guest positions in York University, Cambridge University, Leeds University, JNU, DU, Jamia Millia and other universities. During the virus crisis, he rewrote 21 Shakespeare sonnets as a commentary on the times: *QUARANTINED SONNETS: Sex Money and Shakespeare*. Published by Kitaab, Singapore, the profits will be donated to a 'Covid' charity in Singapore.

G. N. Devy was educated at Shivaji University, Kolhapur and the University of Leeds, UK. Among his many academic assignments, he held fellowships at Leeds University and Yale University and has been THB Symons Fellow (1991-92) and Jawaharlal Nehru Fellow (1994-96). He was Professor of English at the Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda (1980-96).
