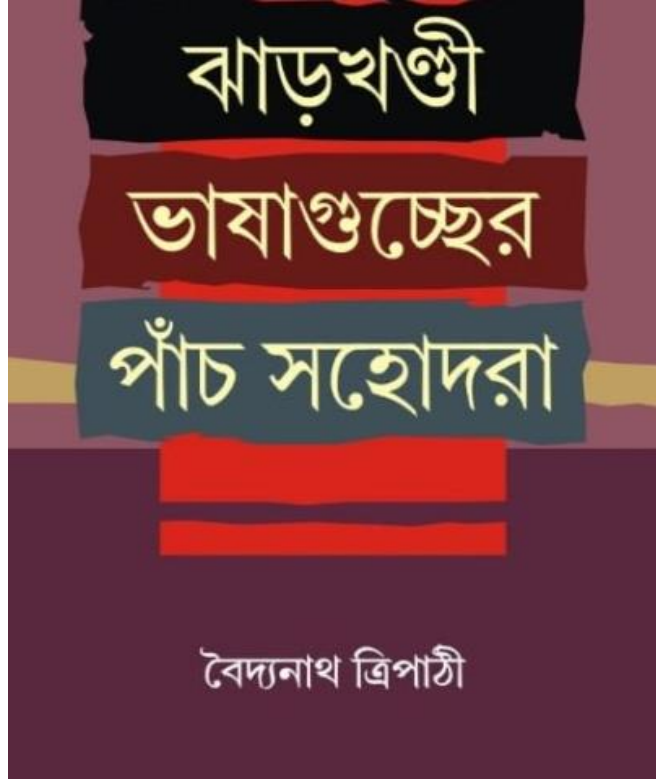


PARA PARSHI

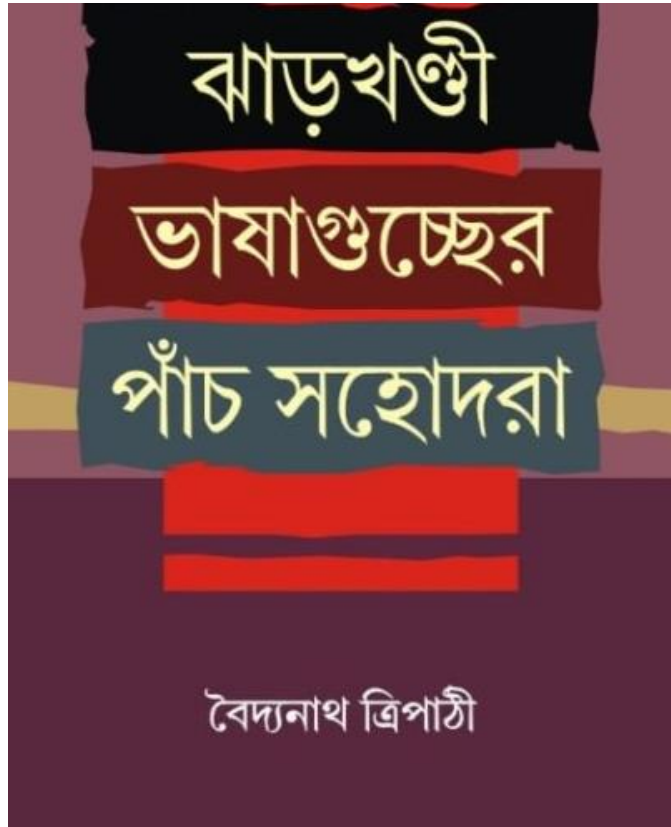


JHARKHANDI BHASHAGUCHER PUNCH SAHODARA

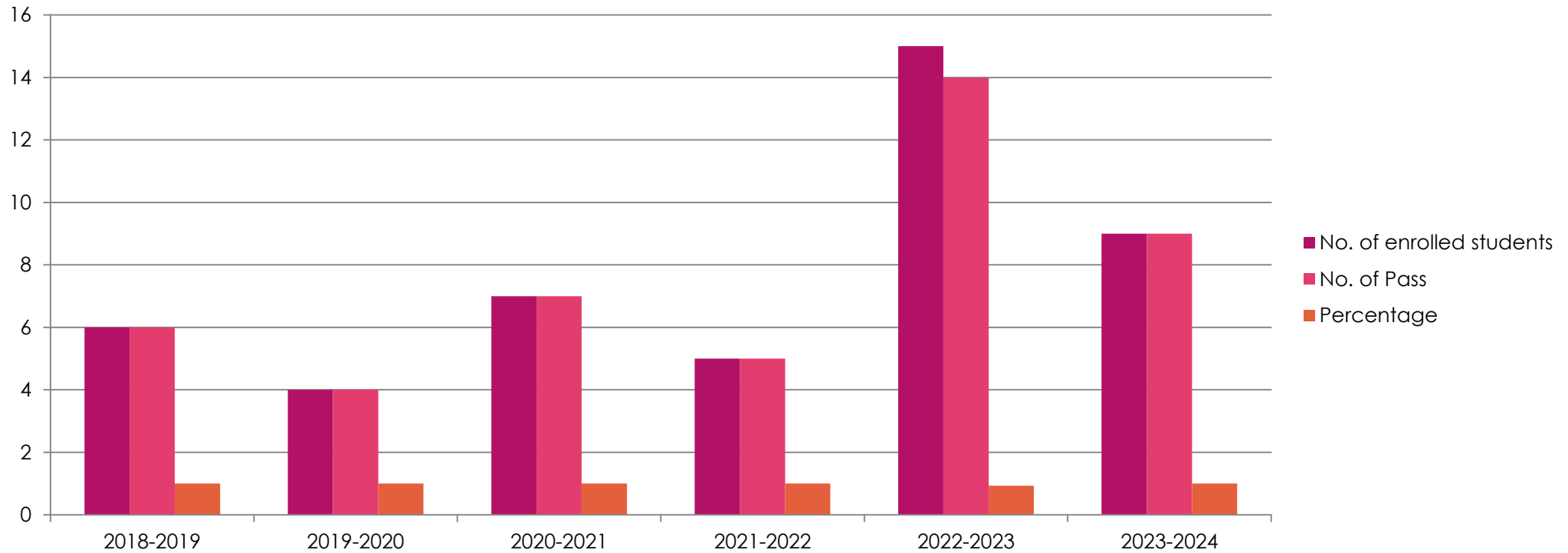

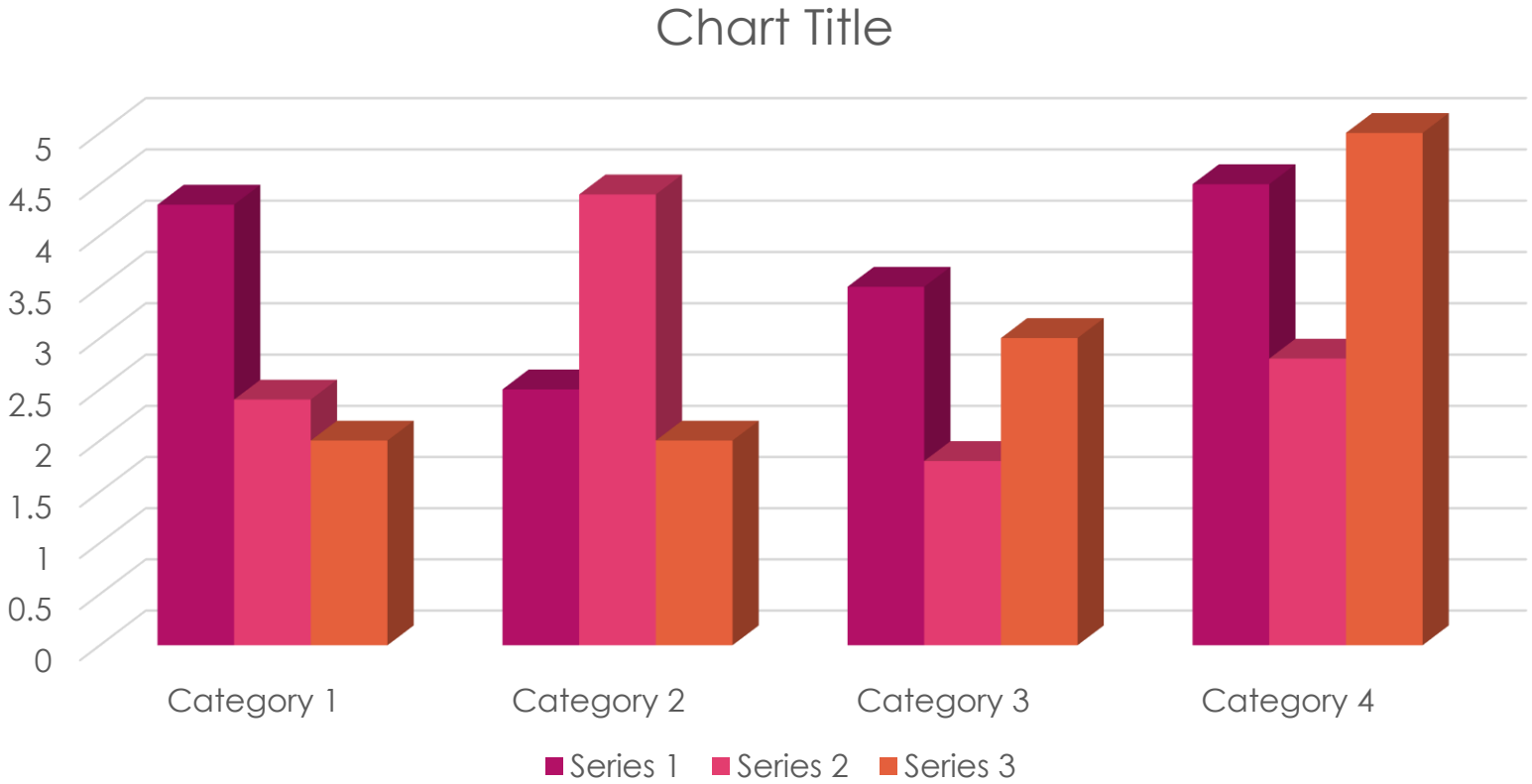
