


STUDENTS ADMISSION DURING FIVE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-20 to 2023-2024

Advanced Learners and Slow Learners


The Department assesses the learning levels of the students and organizes special Programmes for advanced learners and slow learners. To ensure that the required learning has taken place and to best support student learning the Faculty of Commerce assesses student learning through both direct and indirect measures. At the entry level to create a bridge between students' previous knowledge and new material, prior knowledge of students is assessed through a series of multiple-choice questions in the respective classrooms and a mid-semester assessment is conducted which reveals what students have learned, based on the performance students are identified as advanced and slow learners. A separate tutorial class is assigned in the routine where the most important points or the most confusing aspect of the lecture class is revised in a structured way to reach out to each student.






TOTAL NUMBER OF CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMES DURING FIVE ACADEMIC YEARS



TOTAL NUMBER OF PLACEMENTS DURING FIVE ACADEMIC YEARS





KCC students gain hands-on experience at Jamshedpur Dairy

Jamshedpur, Sep 11: M.Com semester-4 students from Karim City College, Jamshedpur, embarked on an insightful industrial visit to Jamshedpur Dairy, gaining valuable hands-on exposure to the dairy industry.
