



General Information/Regulations for the PGDGC

A candidate seeking admission to PGDGC must satisfy following conditions:

- · He/she must be a graduate from any recognized University in any discipline with minimum 50% of marks in the aggregate or equivalent grade.
- · Admission to this course will be based on merit. If number of applicants exceeds double of the seats, there will be an entrance examination followed by the counseling. Reservation of the seats for this course will be as per the admission rules of the University.
